



What is a licenced Connections Link Life facilitator?

This is a facilitator who has paid for their full licence enabling them to deliver Connections Link Life Online Training under the terms upon which their licence has been issued. They will be fully responsible for all organisational governance and operations, related to delivery of this programme.

Should licensees' circumstances change, or should they wish to expand the terms of their licence, licensees should contact Fresh Minds Education to discuss any financial and approval implications.

To deliver Connections Link Life commercially or voluntarily outside of Fresh Minds Education you must be in possession of a licence with terms agreed.

Standards of a Licenced Facilitator:

- Will complete the 'facilitator profile form' demonstrating qualification and experience for delivering to the intended target group.
- Will be in receipt of and work in compliance of the licence agreement and comply with its detail and scope.
- Will attend a Connections Link Life Online Training For Trainers
- Will demonstrate competency in delivering Connections Link Life Online
- Is in receipt of and uses standardised course facilitator guides and course delivery guides.
- Has access to the central Connections Link Life Online Members Area and remains up to date with updates or changes.
- Receives the FME Connections Facilitators News for notification on updates to the members area or information on professional development opportunities.
- Will co-facilitate
- Will attend mentoring meetings
- Will complete facilitator reports, and return, export chat, screenshot and participant registration list.
- Is Insured for the purposes of the role
- Can demonstrate commitment to lifelong learning
- Organisation will be ICO Registered
- Organisation will comply with the PHA Regional Quality Standards for The Prevention of Suicide and Emotional Health Northern Ireland
