



What is a non-licenced Connections Link Life facilitator?

This facilitator has been contracted to deliver Connections Link Life for Fresh Minds Education and has been subject to FME recruitment procedures and induction.

This facilitator has not paid a licence fee.

It is likely that this facilitator is being supported through FME into their facilitator role, being set up with a suitable co-facilitator and offered monthly mentoring and support and receives full organisational support and governance including ICO Registration and compliance with the PHA Regional Quality Standards for The Prevention of Suicide and Emotional Health Northern Ireland. Non-licenced Connections Link Life facilitators are not authorised to deliver Connections Link Life commercially or voluntarily outside of Fresh Minds Education.

Standards of a non-licenced Facilitator:

- Has submitted a CV & supply references.
- Will be in receipt of a contract from Fresh Minds Education outlining roles and responsibilities and will comply with its scope.
- Has attended an FME induction and complies with FME policies and procedures.
- Will complete the 'facilitator profile form' demonstrating qualification and experience.
- Is in receipt of and uses standardised course facilitator guides and course delivery guides.
- Has access to the central Connections Link Life Online Members Area and remains up to date with updates or changes.
- Receives the FME Connections Facilitators News for notification on updates to the members area or information on professional development opportunities.
- Will attend a Connections Link Life Online Training For Trainers or be supported into role with Fresh Minds Education.
- Will demonstrate competency in delivering Connections Link Life Online
- Will co-facilitate
- Will attend regular mentoring meetings
- Will complete facilitator reports, and return, export chat, screenshot & participant registration list.
- Is Insured for the purposes of the role
- Can demonstrate commitment to lifelong learning
